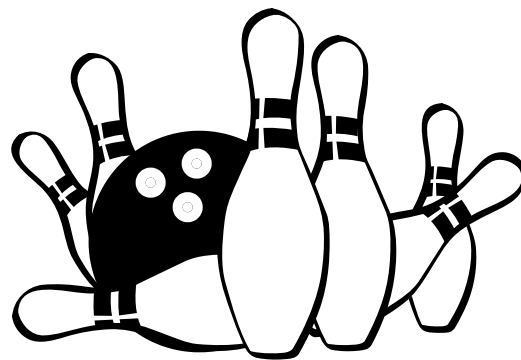

TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. Eligibility:** Participants must be a certified USBC member and in a current certified league. Teams consist of one man and one woman. Also open to touching association members (Canandaigua, Finger Lakes, Genesee Region, Hornell, Penn Yan- Dundee, & Lake Ontario/Wayne County) with a \$9 local association fee. The event is conducted under USBC rules and regulations. This tournament is not SMART Approved.
- 2. Entering average:** Highest certified average from 2022-2023 and 2023-24 season. If no prior average is established, participant must enter tournament with their highest 2024-2025 average as of start of tournament (minimum 21 games). If a bowler does not have a certified average, bowler will use 230. Handicap is 100% of 230 - no minus pins.
- 3. Format:** The tournament consists of three (3) games bowled on one pair of lanes. Tournament management assigns lanes as entries are received. Entrants wishing to bowl together must submit entries together.
- 4. Prizes and Awards:** All prize fees will be returned (100%). Cash prizes are awarded on a handicap basis in both divisions. You may cash more than once by changing partners. First place team winners each receive a plaque.
- 5. Award Criteria:** Total pins plus handicap for three games determines prize winners.
- 6. Exceptions:** Bowler must provide Tournament Management with their league standing sheet before bowling. Sport and challenge averages will be adjusted according to current USBC rules. Bowlers with no average bowl scratch.
- 7. Check-In Procedure:** Entrants are requested to report one-half hour prior to the scheduled squad time. Bowlers are required to present their current USBC membership card.
- 8. Unscheduled Walk-Ins:** Call the bowling center to check for lane availability and please be there ½ hour prior to the scheduled squad time.
- 9. Disputes:** Any disputes will be discussed by the tournament committee and decisions will be made by the tournament director, whose decision is final.
- 10. Entry fee includes:** prize fund - \$30, lineage fee - \$15.00, and expenses - \$5.00. Prize fund pays 1:6 bowlers. All prize money paid out 100%. Refunds will be processed if a bowler alerts the Tournament Director within 24 hours of the scheduled event.
- 11. Make checks payable to the Rochester NY USBC.** There will be a \$30.00 fee for returned checks. NO checks will be accepted on day of the tournament.
- 12. All USBC rules will be in effect except rule 319D.** Participants should note rules 319A-3, 319B, and 319C. Adequate entering average also re-rating (USBC rule 319E.)

Squad Leaders who bring 5 teams will receive a free entry.
